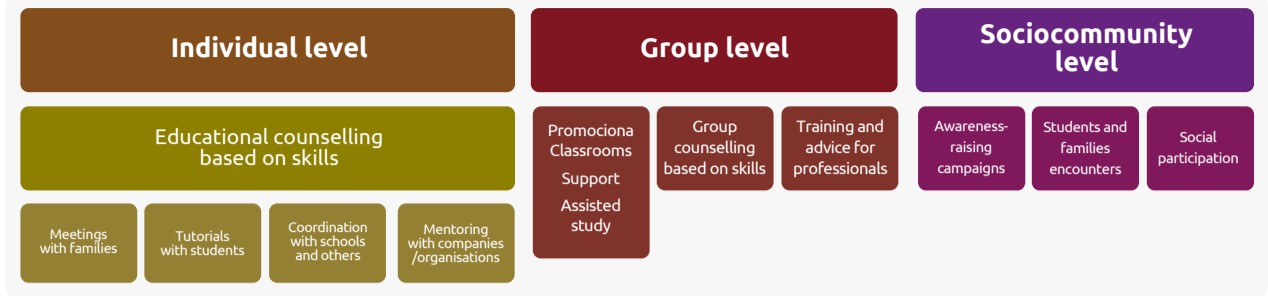

Educational success is possible for Roma students, as shown by the results of hundreds of young people who have taken part in our Education programmes.

PROMOCIONA-T



With *Promociona-T* we prevent absenteeism and early school dropout among Roma students in Infant Education, Primary Education, Basic Vocational Training and Compulsory Secondary Education, and we help them progress through the curriculum.



RESULTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

**1.676** students  
**49%** girls

Main results:

**95%** of primary students passed their school year. **58%** passed all their subjects.  
**75%** of students in Compulsory Secondary Education passed their school year. **49%** passed all their subjects.

PROMOCIONA



With *Promociona* we support the educational success of Roma students in the final years of Primary Education (5th and 6th years) and in Compulsory Secondary Education so they can graduate from compulsory education and access post-compulsory education.



RESULTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

**1.434** students  
**56%** girls

Main results:

**64%** moved from Primary to Compulsory Secondary Education, passing all their subjects  
**88%** graduated from Compulsory Secondary Education **185 boys and girls**  
**93%** went on to post-compulsory education

PROMOCIONA+



With *Promociona+* we work to enable Roma students enrolled in post-compulsory education (Intermediate and Advanced Vocational Training, Advanced Secondary Education and University) to complete their studies and gain a qualification.



RESULTS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

**313** students  
**59%** girls

Main results:

**93%** continued with their studies  
**84%** were able to gain a qualification **96 students gained a qualification**
